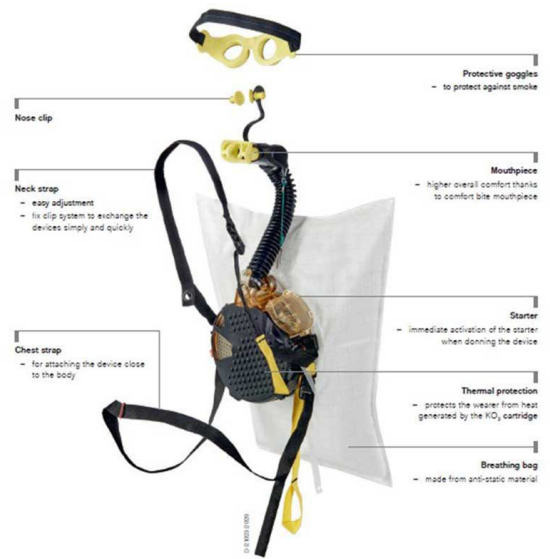

Robust double housing product concept

The metal and plastic exterior shell with an interior integrated shock absorber protects the KO₂ cartridge against damage in harsh environments such as mining, sewage work, and the petrochemical industry. The exterior shell will be left behind when the device is activated. This feature allows employees safe, effective and uncomplicated escape from the hazardous environment.

Crumple zone and service indicator

In what condition is your Dräger Oxy 3000 self-rescuer? Based on the position and depth of the dent in the exterior shell, the user can estimate the mechanical stresses the device has been subjected to. In addition, a glance through the service indicator is enough to ascertain if the KO₂ cartridge is undamaged. The user can immediately identify if moisture or KO₂ fragments are present inside the unit without using test equipment.

Less maintenance, lower costs

Thanks to its robust construction, the Dräger Oxy 3000 MK III can be used maintenance-free for ten years. The quick, uncomplicated visual inspection of the exterior shell and the Safety Eye provide certainty about the device's functionality. These features allow the user to reduce the risk for employees and operating costs.

Also available

The Dräger Oxy 6000 MK III gives the user 60 minutes of oxygen to reach the next safe area or complete a successful escape. The availability of a 60-minute device provides more options in your emergency planning concept.

Robust and always under control: the oxygen self-rescuer Dräger Oxy 3000 is designed to handle the harshest conditions. The safety eye provides an additional level of security: the status window allows the user to assess whether the device is operating within seconds.

Note: The Draeger Ocy3000 Mk III Self Container Rescuer is a single-use item for emergency use. The unit needs to be replaced once the seal on the outer case has been broken. The unit has a shelf life of approximately 10 years based on normal storage, this would be less if the unit is exposed to adverse conditions. The 10 years is the maximum life from the date of entering service and only applies to unopened devices. The anti-tamper seal can be replaced if it is damaged or comes off without the straps released from the unit. This can happen if the opening latch is lifted slightly by accident.
